Minutes of the Council
July 9, 2019

The following are the minutes of the Council meeting held on Tuesday, July 9, 2019. In attendance for the Council: Dan Diekmann, Vickie Leinen, Ryan Schieck, Steve Wieneke and Mayor Jill Diekmann. Mayor Diekmann called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

On a motion by Vickie and seconded by Dan it was duly passed to approve the Agenda. On a motion by Dan and seconded by Ryan it was duly passed to approve the minutes of the meeting held on June 11, 2019. On a motion by Steve and seconded by Vickie, it was duly passed to approve the financial statement, pay the invoices and make the stated transfers.

On a motion by Steve and seconded by Vickie it was duly passed to approve a building permit to Heartland Mutual Insurance for an attached garage to the rear of their property on the east side. Also acknowledged was the approved 12' overhanging to be installed at the American Legion building.

On a motion by Dan and seconded by Steve it was duly passed to approve a beer permit to St. Anthony Church for their annual church bazaar held on September 8, 2019.

Fire Department report: Jim Weidert, Fire Chief advised the Council they are switching radios in the new pumper. There will be some firefighters serving at annual Ribs & Rims in Adrian on July 19, 2019. They will also participate in the Adrian parade on July 20, 2019. On a motion by Ryan and seconded by Dan it was duly passed to approve the Fire Department report.

Justin Ahlers gave the maintenance report. Justin reported he will be patching 3rd Street between Rice and 1st Street. There was a request to remove boulevard trees on 4th Street. The Council felt that if the property owner wanted the trees removed it would be their responsibility. On a motion by Vickie and seconded by Ryan it was duly passed to approve the maintenance report.

Kate McCann gave the clerk's report. Kate reported there is on-line training for the Local Board of Review certificate. Information will be available for later in the year to whoever is interested in taking the training. The Department of Health has notified the City there will be an annual increase from \$6.36 to \$9.72 on the drinking water service connection fee. Discussion was held on the various fees paid on the utility billings. On a motion by Steve and seconded by Ryan it was duly passed to approve the clerk's report.

Ordinance Violations: Mailings were sent on the property located at 220 4th Street, Lismore, MN for personal delivery of ordinance violations. Correspondence was received by email, from another property owner in response to being notified of ordinance violation on long grass and weeds. A work order was ordered to mow the lawn and a bill was sent to property owner. Other properties were discussed.

With no further business to discuss on a motion by Steve and seconded by Ryan it was duly passed to adjourn the meeting. The next City Council meeting will be held on Tuesday, August 13, 2019.
